

Accessing VUW Guest Wi-Fi

1. Browse your device's Wi-Fi connections
2. Select WellingtonUniversityGuest wireless network
3. You will be redirected to a web portal. If you are not redirected, open a web browser, and attempt to connect to <http://wifi.vuw.ac.nz>
